The TSRP is responsible for providing state-specific training and technical assistance to prosecutors and law enforcement officers across New Hampshire on traffic safety-related investigations, prosecutions, and developments in the law -- with specific emphasis on impaired driving offenses. The TSRP drafts pleadings, memos, and appellate briefs; assists in trial preparation; serves as co-counsel on DUI cases in circuit court; and collects and analyzes all DUI reduction letters submitted by authorities state-wide.

The ideal candidate will have significant litigation experience (focused on impaired driving offenses), excellent oral and written communication skills, and the ability to work constructively with prosecutors and law enforcement officers in the field.
