Within four to six weeks you will be receiving a check which represents the first disbursement from Flynn's Oil Company. The amount you receive was calculated with a formula that divided the amount of money that you were owed by the total amount of money owed to all consumers in this case. That percentage was multiplied by the total amount of money that we hold in escrow \$36,882.15 (from the sale of Flynn's Oil Company to Hilton Family Oil) giving us the amount of your first payment.

Please be advised that another disbursement will not take place until a significant amount of money has been escrowed – which may be well over a year. Any future disbursement checks will not be preceded by a letter from this Office, rather they will be sent directly from the State Treasury.
