Dear Mr. Delaney:

On behalf of The Coca-Cola Company ("Coca-Cola"), I am writing to inform you about a recent incident involving personal information relating to certain Coca-Cola employees and other individuals who are New Hampshire residents.

We recently discovered the theft of several laptops assigned to current CCR and former CCE users that included personnel information. We began investigating the incident as soon as we learned of it. Although our investigation is ongoing, we have not been able to determine when the laptops were stolen. We have successfully recovered the laptops. Nonetheless, we have determined that one or more of the laptops included certain employee or other individual names and Social Security Numbers, Driver's License Numbers, or other government identification numbers. The Coca-Cola employee who is believed to have stolen the laptops has been suspended pending the outcome of the investigation. We are engaged with appropriate law enforcement on the matter.

We will begin providing notice regarding this incident to our employees on January 24, 2014, including providing notice to 17 employees and other individuals who are New Hampshire residents. In addition, we will be offering these individuals credit monitoring at no cost to them.
