Dear Attorney General Foster,

The purpose of this letter is to notify you that Granite State College of 25 Hall Street, Concord, NH recently experienced a security breach. In accordance with Title XXXI Trade and Commerce, Chapter 359-C:20 we hereby notify your office of the security breach involving electronically-stored personal information regarding three individuals that are associated with Granite State College. We believe the inadvertent distribution of a faculty listing to a hijacked staff email account occurred on October 16, 2013 and it came to my attention on November 13, 2013. Personal information may have been accessed by an unauthorized person(s) that includes each individual's first name, last name and Granite State College identifier (a 9-digit SSN alternative no.), course assignment, campus location, type of course delivery, associated hiring director's name, and recent teaching compensation information. The information was inadvertently sent to an unidentifiable, phishing email address: jamesnancy007 @ gmail . com.

Today we sent written notice via the U.S. Postal Service to each of the individuals informing them of the unauthorized access to their information and providing to them credit monitoring and credit security freeze information should they decide to pursue either or both of these options.
