Dear \_\_\_\_\_ :

As part of Lockheed Martin's continued vigilance of personal information privacy matters, I am writing to inform you about an incident that resulted in the potential compromise of your personal information.

After containing the incident, which occurred in April 2009, the Corporation took prudent measures to conduct a thorough analysis of the incident and implement solutions to deter future occurrences. The analysis confirmed that the compromised data contained some of your personal information including your name and Social Security Number. The fact that certain pieces of your personal data were compromised does not necessarily mean misuse of this data will occur. However, I wanted to alert you that it remains a possibility even though we have received no reports to date that indicate this information has been widely disclosed or otherwise misused.

We also want to help you take appropriate, prudent measures to protect your identity. Lockheed Martin is offering you a complimentary one-year membership in PrivacyGuard®, a national subscription credit monitoring service that provides you with access to your credit report from all three national credit reporting agencies and daily monitoring of your credit file from a national credit reporting agency. Your participation is completely voluntary.

If you choose to accept the PrivacyGuard service, you may enroll in one of two ways:

- 1) Sign up online at [www.privacyguard.com/breachshield-027](http://www.privacyguard.com/breachshield-027) and enter the requested information including your individual online Activation Code, which is \_\_\_\_\_.
- 2) To sign up via postal mail, please complete, sign, and mail the enclosed enrollment form.

We encourage you to remain vigilant in reviewing your account statements and monitor your credit report frequently using the resources being offered to you.

The company encourages you to promptly report any suspected identity theft to law enforcement and file a police report. Get a copy of the report; many creditors want the information it contains to absolve you of any fraudulent debts.

You can also file a complaint with the Federal Trade Commission (FTC), or contact them for general information about identity theft prevention and recovery. Here is the FTC contact information:

You can also request a security freeze to help protect your privacy. A security freeze is designed to prevent a credit reporting company from releasing your credit report without your consent. You can request a security freeze by contacting each of the three consumer reporting agencies. The consumer reporting agencies may charge a reasonable fee (typically \$5.00 to place and either \$5.00 or free to remove) to freeze your account and may require that you provide proper identification (such as your full name, Social Security Number, date of birth, and current address) prior to honoring your request. Please note that a security freeze is distinct from the complimentary PrivacyGuard service offered to you above.

For your convenience, below is a list of major consumer reporting agencies. Keep in mind that if you sign up for the service mentioned above, PrivacyGuard will contact these agencies as part of the offering so you will not need to contact them separately, unless you would like to also request a security freeze.

I would like to emphasize that Lockheed Martin takes the privacy of your data very seriously and we truly regret this incident occurred. We are continuing the investigation into this incident and are working to identify ways to prevent data breaches and educate employees on appropriate behaviors that minimize risks.
