Dear Attorney General Foster:

Pursuant to New Hampshire law (N.H. REV. STAT. ANN. § 359-C:20(I)(b)), I write to notify your office of a data security incident involving two NBC Sports laptops that were stolen from a locked vehicle in Northern California on the evening of August 24, 2013. NBC Sports is working with law enforcement authorities in connection with the investigation of this incident.

NBC Sports has determined that the stolen laptops likely contained personal information, including approximately 6 New Hampshire residents' names, plus at least one of the following data elements:

- Social Security Number
- Driver's License Number
- Date of Birth

At this juncture, NBC Sports does not have any evidence that any personal information about the potentially affected New Hampshire residents has been or is being used or disclosed to other persons.

NBC Sports is in the process of notifying the New Hampshire residents whose personal information was potentially compromised. We anticipate that notices to these residents will be distributed on 10/14/13.

NBC Sports is also taking action to mitigate any risk of potential harm, including steps to prevent any future unauthorized access to NBC Sports' computer assets.
