To the New Hampshire Department of Justice:

On July 23, 2014, a brokerage firm ("Firm") that has a business relationship with us notified us that, on July 22, 2014, the names, account numbers and social security numbers of certain individuals who hold Oppenheimer Fund accounts and whose addresses of record are listed in New Hampshire ("Shareholders") were erroneously made accessible to a registered representative of the Firm. Since the Firm is not associated with these Shareholder accounts, the registered representative was not authorized to receive this information.

We resolved the issue that caused this error on the same day we were notified, namely on July 23, 2014, and we are notifying Shareholders of this incident (see enclosed form notice). We will also be notifying the three major credit reporting agencies (*i.e.*, Equifax, Experian, and Trans Union).
