

RE: ***House of Windsor Inc. and all of its Brands Removed from the New Hampshire Directory***

DATE: March 11, 2016

Please note that the New Hampshire Attorney General's Office has issued a notice of intent to remove the tobacco manufacturer, *House of Windsor, Inc.* and its brands and brand styles from the New Hampshire Directory of Certified Tobacco Manufacturers and Brands ("Directory"). The removal of *House of Windsor, Inc.* and its brands from the Directory will be effective **April 1, 2016**. The following is a list of *House of Windsor, Inc.* brands that will be delisted: ***House of Windsor Light, House of Windsor Menthol, House of Windsor Regular, and House of Windsor Ultra Light.***

Under New Hampshire law, it is unlawful for any person to stamp, sell, offer, or possess for sale cigarettes (including RYO) of a tobacco manufacturer or a brand family not included in the Directory. Any cigarettes that are sold, offered for sale, or possessed for sale that are not included in the Directory are considered contraband and subject to seizure and forfeiture.
